 - Cash flow statement- approx. \$114,000 after fun run fundraising.
 - End the year with approximately \$75,000.
 - Good fundraising allows for PTO to approve more non-budget item request from teachers and staff.

 - o Fun Run
 - Fundraising goal met: BSE families raised \$33,521
 - Net profit \$30,224
 - 44% registered/ 654 students
 - 40% pledged/654 students
 - This is Shannon's last year as fun run chair if anyone is interested in taking this committee over.
 - Blue Sage Bash
 - Bash was a success and thank you to Mandy for all her work planning. BSE families had a great time.
 - September Family Dinner Night
